



Pacific Vinca

Catharanthus roseus (Upright Vinca)

Pacific Vinca (Upright Vinca) grows 10 – 14 inches high and 6 – 8 inches wide and blooms late spring through late summer. Plant in full sun. Although this plant does well in hot, dry and sunny conditions, it is also tolerant of cool, wet growing conditions.



Petunia

Petunias do best in full sun but can handle partial shade, especially in hotter areas. Although petunias like cool weather, they are not frost tolerant. When planting, pinch the seedling back to encourage more branching and a fuller plant. Petunias will tolerate a range of soil pH. They don't like to be dry for long periods, but they also don't like wet feet.
